NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the Election Commission of India had announced the schedule for Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls in the State of Maharashtra with reference to 1st January, 2022 as the qualifying date vide its letter No. 23/2021-ERS (Vol.-II) dated 3rd August, 2021; and

Whereas, the period of filing claims and objections was fixed from 1st November, 2021 to 30th November, 2021; and

Whereas, the draft roll was published on 1st November, 2021 in respect of all Assembly constituencies of the State; and

Whereas, the Chief Electoral Officer, Maharashtra has requested the Commission to extend the period of filing claims and objection till 10th December, 2021; and

Whereas, the Election Commission of India has, on review of the progress of ongoing exercise of SSR in the State, decided that the period of filing claims and objections should be extended up to 5th December, 2021 (Sunday), in order to give more time to all the eligible persons to file their claims and objections.

Now, therefore, the Election Commission of India, in exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Rule 12 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, hereby extends for all Assembly Constituencies in the state of Maharashtra, the period for filing claims and objections upto and including 5th December, 2021 for ongoing Special Summary Revision of electoral rolls with reference to 01.01.2022 as the qualifying date. Schedule for all the remaining activities of SSR will remain unchanged.
